## Description

Some administrators may not want users to change information about their own account, such as their password, e-mail address, description, and existence of their user album. This will typically occur in scenarios where the gallery is integrated into an existing page and the developer does not wish this information to be exposed.

Add a configuration setting that prevents a user from navigating to their account page and does not render the link to their account page that normally appears at the top right of every page.

## Notes

Added configuration setting allowManageOwnAccount and exposed it on the User Settings page in the Site admin area.

Also included in this feature is new functionality on the Edit User dialog on the Manage Users page to allow an administrator to enable/disable a user's user album. This allows an administrator to do everything that a user can do on their account page. The functionality for editing e-mail address, description, changing password, and deleting account was already present.
